

Language Teacher Job Description

Drumduan School is looking for a part-time Language Teacher to teach a foreign language to a range of ages: 6 - 14 years old (Classes 1 - 8) for 10hrs/week.

Lower School: (class 1-4, ages 6-10)

- Teach and engage the children in the culture and the language of the country taught in a fun way through the means of vocabulary building, poetry, games, songs, drama, stories, drawings...
- \square Teach every day's vocabulary to the children and increase it as the years' progress
- Teach and engage pupils with a wide range of songs which follow the seasons, festivals and general vocabulary.
- □ Encourage pupils to join in the different elements of the lessons, enabling them to grow in confidence.
- □ Support the children in preparing items for performances at festivals and end-of-term performances.

Middle School: (class 5-8, ages 11-14)

- $\hfill\square$ Revise and develop further what has been learnt in the Lower School
- \square Introduce writing in the Foreign Language, initially using all that has been learnt orally \square
- Introduce the grammatical elements of the foreign language creatively and engagingly [] Work
- collaboratively with other teachers to support a wide range of abilities

- □ Have experience teaching a foreign language to a range of ages, including adolescents □ Be comfortable holding and teaching a mixed group of varying abilities.
- □ Have enthusiasm for teaching a foreign language to children
- □ Be able to teach (or be willing to learn to teach) from an understanding of what is developmentally appropriate for children at different ages; that is to teach from Steiner Waldorf education. □ Attend relevant weekly staff meetings, held outside of school operating hours, to discuss pedagogical and other matters relevant to the school.
- □ Share responsibility for taking part in parent's meetings as appropriate, including one-to-one meetings where needed.
