Shelley is an artist, educator, author and cultural activist well known internationally for her work in the field of social sculpture and connective practice that links imagination and a widened understanding of art with education and transformation. She has worked with thousands of people for five decades in social, artistic and educational fields, offering 'connective practices' that enhance capacities for personal and social enlivenment. Recent experiences include work in Stockholm with 60 Waldorf teachers and staff from teacher education colleges, her keynote for the 'Human Intelligence' global conference for Waldorf educators in Vienna,

and an intensive work in mainstream schools in Germany. These interactions have inspired new ways of exploring 'education for freedom' and 'the aesthetic education of the human being' that emphasize the value of the human being in our work toward a living ecological-social future.
